Tamara Kostianovsky. Moved by Forces.

When: September 6 – October 25, 2025

Where: SLAG&RX, New York City, United States

Argentinian-American artist Tamara Kostianovsky presents her latest works in New York's SLAG&RX. Spanning textile "carcass" sculptures and installations, *Moved by Forces is a* poignant exploration of corporeality and natural environment through the ecofeminist lens. In her work, Kostianovsky repurposes her own clothing to comment on consumerism and the climate crisis. The artist urges her viewers to draw parallels between violence towards women and animals.

The dynamic, organic work transcends the spatial boundaries of the exhibition space, asserting an affinity between humans, the natural world, and architecture. *Moved by Forces* lies at the intersection of horror and beauty, the human and the non-human, transforming fixed ideas of embodiment.
